Beginning at $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North ~~corner~~ corner of this lot and on the boundary of Rice and Kula Lot 1 (General Lease No. 612 to Hee Fat), from which Government Survey Trig. Station "South Base" is by true azimuth and distance $228^{\circ} 00' 30''$ 408.5 feet, Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth $71^{\circ} 28'$ and the Spire of the Native Church is by true azimuth $196^{\circ} 52'$, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2450, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $26^{\circ} 08'$ 207.0 feet along West bank of ditch;
2. $26^{\circ} 51'$ 297.1 feet along West bank of ditch;
3. $102^{\circ} 39'$ 111.3 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
4. $193^{\circ} 42'$ 203.4 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
5. $171^{\circ} 40'$ 163.2 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
6. $257^{\circ} 42'$ 316.6 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1 to the point of beginning.
