Station "Aku" being 3956.7 feet South and 2549.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 189° 50' 1221.5 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to a post;
2. 270° 00' 766.7 feet along Lot 42 to a post;
3. 360° 00' 1203.5 feet along Lot 49 to a post on the North side of the 20 foot road;
4. 90° 00' 975.3 feet along the North side of the 20 foot road to the point of beginning.
