Beginning at a + on stone at the West corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 5 and on the Northeast side of ~~Opai-~~^{Opae-} kaa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" being 976.4 feet South and 5030.1 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2601, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 199° 35' 1783.4 feet along Lot 5 to a + on stone;
2. 288° 38' 829.9 feet along Lot 136, Kapaa Homesteads 2nd. Series, to a pipe;
3. 278° 51' 441.2 feet along same to a + on stone;
4. 47° 52' 2193.0 feet along Lots 1 and 2 and the Northwest side of Kamalu Road, to a + on stone;
5. 122° 35' 230.0 feet along the Northeast side of Opai-kaa Road to the point of beginning.

Area 30-73/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving the waters and all riparian and other rights in or to the streams ~~and roads and in or to the~~ ~~streams~~ passing over and across said lot.

Also, excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way twenty (20) feet wide for the railroad across this lot, said right-of-way containing an area of 1-20/100 Acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 29-53/100 ACRES.
