KAUPAKUEA HOMESTEADS,
South Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 4, and on the North side of a 30 foot Homestead Road; the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 258.3 feet North, and 4071.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2546, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 161° 30' 1064.5 feet along Lot 4 to Kapehu Stream;
2. Thence along the middle of Kapehu Stream to a point, the direct azimuth and distance being; 235° 31' 539.8 feet;
3. 341° 30' 1281.9 feet along Lot 6;
4. 57° 49' 55.8 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road;
5. 49° 27' 113.8 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road;
6. 117° 40' 111.2 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road;
7. 80° 29' 285.8 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road; to point of beginning.
