Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at the Southwest corner of this Lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 55, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being: 8751.0 feet North and 5701.5 feet East, and the azimuth and distance to a similar $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at Trig. Station "R" being: $180^{\circ} 00' 45.0$ feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $180^{\circ} 00'$ 774.3 feet along Kaauhuhu Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $288^{\circ} 05'$ 1258.1 feet along Grant 2390 to Kalamanu and Grant 2462 to Kaohe to an iron rail;
3. $7^{\circ} 20'$ 279.2 feet along L.C.A. 8309 to Kekaha to an iron rail;
4. $357^{\circ} 20'$ 107.0 feet along L.C.A. 8309 to Kekaha to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 1165.4 feet along Lot 55 to the point of beginning.

Area 15-70/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom, however, a right-of-way 15 feet wide for the Hawi Mill and Plantation Company's flume, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 15-44/100 ACRES.
