Station "Transit of Venus" being 513.2 feet South and 640.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2596, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $119^{\circ} 36' 30''$ 95.6 feet along new North side of Government Main Road;
2. $242^{\circ} 04'$ 24.8 feet along roadway leading to Waimea Hall;
3. $265^{\circ} 12'$ 73.1 feet along stonewall;
4. $10^{\circ} 08'$ 66.0 feet along L.C.A. 6694, Ap. 2, to Leleinaholo, to the point of beginning.
