Beginning at a mamane post at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 7 on the East side of the Waiohuli road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 5859.8 feet South and 17569.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 223° 30' 46.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
2. 285° 43' 121.0 feet along L.C.A. 8808 to Kakeleiaiku;
3. 322° 13' 191.4 feet along L.C.A. 8808 to Kakeleiaiku;
4. 213° 13' 270.6 feet along L.C.A. 8808 to Kakeleiaiku;
5. 135° 43' 300.0 feet along L.C.A. 8808 to Kakeleiaiku to a mamane post on the East side of the Waiohuli road;
6. 210° 53' 352.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
7. 309° 46' 1938.0 feet along Lot 5 to a mamane post on the boundary of the mauka pasture lands;
8. 39° 46' 700.0 feet along the mauka pasture lands to a mamane post;
9. 129° 46' 1856.0 feet along Lot 7 to the point of beginning.
