2. 302° 19' 454.0 feet along L.C.A. 10828:2 to Palaile and Government Land to a guava post;
3. 202° 21' 392.0 feet along trail to a guava post;
4. 114° 35' 393.0 feet along Lots 2 and 6A to a guava post;
5. 175° 30' 23.0 feet along Lot 6A to a guava post;
6. 113° 15' 28.0 feet along Lot 6A to the initial point.
