Beginning at a pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 7 and on the South side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1704.4 feet North and 2932.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 271° 18' 30" 275.6 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe;
2. 265° 23' 263.1 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe;
3. 358° 23' 1088.55 feet along Lot 5 across a small stream to a post, the same being 10 feet from the edge of the stream;
4. Southwesterly on a line parallel to and 10 feet from the edge of the stream to a point, the direct azimuth and distance being: 79° 43' 30" 216.4 feet;
5. 93° 30" 325.0 feet along the land of Papaikou to a post;
6. 178° 23' 1092.4 feet along Lot 7 across a small stream to the point of beginning.
