Beginning at the West angle of Homestead

66, the boundary runs,

1. N. $57^{\circ} 02'$ E. "true" 427 feet along lot # 66 to the East angle
at the edge of the Hauani gulch.
2. N. $30^{\circ} 53'$ W. " 1300 feet along edge of Hauani gulch and the
East boundary of the Puukapu
reservation.
3. N. $70^{\circ} 43'$ W. " 664 feet along East boundary of Puukapu
reservation to the North angle
on the crest of the Puukapu slope
4. S. $30^{\circ} 53'$ E. " 1825 feet along Lot # 69 to the South angle
and Initial Point which bears
from the Haw. Gov't Survey \triangle ^{end}
Sta. "Puukiki" N. $90^{\circ} 00'$ E. true
dist. 196.5 feet.

Reserving however a strip of land for road purposes 20 feet in
width between Stations 2 and 4.
