Beginning at a + on a stone at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Rice and Kula Lot 5, from which Government Survey Trig. Station "Nonou" is by true azimuth  $75^{\circ} 15'$  and the Spire of the Native Church is by true azimuth  $200^{\circ} 17'$ , as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2450, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $261^{\circ} 23'$  296.4 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 5 to + on stone;
2.  $3^{\circ} 44'$  94.6 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 7;
3.  $80^{\circ} 38'$  84.8 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 7;
4.  $349^{\circ} 40'$  292.4 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 7;
5.  $81^{\circ} 51'$  86.0 feet along base of bank;
6.  $156^{\circ} 30'$  70.7 feet along base of bank;
7.  $118^{\circ} 09'$  72.8 feet to top of bank;
8.  $159^{\circ} 48'$  160.0 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1;
9.  $168^{\circ} 42'$  116.6 feet along Rice and Kula Lot 1 to the point of beginning.
