Beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of this lot, on the boundary of the land of Pakini-iki, and on the South side of a 30 foot road, the coordinates of said post referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Aku" being 6021.6 feet South and 2907.0 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2479, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 270° 00' 1001.8 feet along the South side of the 30 foot road to a post;
2. 360° 00' 972.2 feet along Lot 70 to a post;
3. 90° 00' 1170.3 feet along Lots 76 and 75 to a post;
4. 189° 50' 986.7 feet along the land of Pakini-iki to the point of beginning.
