Beginning at a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe at the Southeast corner of this Lot and the Northeast corner of Lot 69, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being: 8097.7 feet North and 4539.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $90^{\circ} 00'$  1416.5 feet along Lot 69 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
2.  $182^{\circ} 25'$  520.4 feet along Government land of Kahai to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
3.  $270^{\circ} 00'$  1384.7 feet along Lot 71 to a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch pipe;
4.  $358^{\circ} 54'$  520.0 feet along Hawi Road to the point of beginning.
