KIOLAKAA-KEAA HOMESTEAD LOTS.

KAU, HAWAII.

Lot 7.

Beginning at triangle mark on solid rock and ahu on Kaluapuhi rocky knoll at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 11119.5 feet S. and 10742.9 feet E. , and from which said Akihi bears N 44° 32' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-

1. N 00° 27' E 2179 feet along Government Reservation and across Govt.

Road to + on rock and ahu on a slight rise;

2. S 87° 35' W 916 feet along the same to + on rock and ahu;

3. N 13° 8' W 1250 feet along Grant 3635, Kealohaai;

4. N 77° 46' E 2827 feet along Lot 6;

5. S 3° 10' E 1001 feet along Lot 22;

6. S 3° 10' E 910 feet along Lot 23;

7. S 3° 10' E 1686 feet along Lot 24 and across Govt. Road to a point
92 feet makai of stone wall;

8. S 78° 26' W 1817 feet along Grant 2759, S. Nakaikuaana, to the initial
point and containing an area of 169-5/10 Acres.

Exclusive of a Government Reservation, 60 feet wide, through which the
Government Road passes.
