## Revised Description.

Lot 71.

Manowaiopae Homesteads,  
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the West corner of Lot 70, and on the North side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 6654.5 feet South and 4919.8 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 118° 35' 428.0 feet along Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 208° 35' 1478.5 feet along Lot 72 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 269° 10' 126.3 feet along near the South edge of Manowaiopae Gulch;
4. 288° 45' 314.0 feet along near the South edge of Manowaiopae Gulch;
5. 19° 44' 54.6 feet along near the West edge of Manowaiopae Gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 28° 35' 1540.3 feet along Lot 70 to the point of beginning.

Area 15-25/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide for a proposed flume over this lot, which said flume will be parallel to <sup>and past</sup> the North boundary of said lot, (area 15/100 acre) LEAVING A NET AREA OF 15-10/100 ACRES.
