Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at the Northeast corner of this Lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 72, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being: 9117.5 feet North and 4519.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $358^{\circ} 54'$ 500.0 feet along Hawi Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 1384.7 feet along Lot 70 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $182^{\circ} 25'$ 500.3 feet along Government land of Kahei to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 1354.0 feet along Lot 72 to the point of beginning.
