Beginning at a + on a square stone (with MCB cut on the East side of it) at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 72 on the boundary of Lawai, Government Survey Trig. Station "Papapaholahola" is by true azimuth and distance $136^{\circ} 11'$ 6086.9 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $26^{\circ} 20'$ 685.8 feet along the land of Lawai to a + on a square stone (with MCB cut on the East side of it);
2. $112^{\circ} 00'$ 892.0 feet along Lot 74 crossing a gully and over a ridge into Kalahao gulch to a + on stone;
3. $240^{\circ} 43'$ 186.7 feet along the road to a + on stone;
4. $174^{\circ} 55'$ 507.7 feet along the road to a + on stone;
5. $188^{\circ} 52'$ 89.1 feet along the road to a + on stone;
6. $292^{\circ} 00'$ 1078.8 feet over ridge across gully and flat along Lot 72 to the point of beginning.
