KAUPAKUEA HOMESTEADS,

Beginning at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 6, and on the North side of a 30 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 393.1 feet North and 5048.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2546, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 161° 30' 1407.3 feet along Lot 6 to pipe in Kapehu Stream;
2. Thence along the middle of Kapehu Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being 256° 09' 451.1 feet;
3. 341° 30' 1475.0 feet along Lot 8;
4. 88° 30' 253.5 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road;
5. 79° 46' 209.4 feet along 30 foot Homestead Road to the point of beginning;
