Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at the Northeast corner of this Lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 76, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being 11234.7 feet North and 4465.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $357^{\circ} 48'$ 544.4 feet along Hawi Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
2. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 1254.5 feet along Lot 74 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $182^{\circ} 25'$ 544.5 feet along Government land of Kahei to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 1210.6 feet along Lot 76 to the point of beginning.
