Beginning at a 1½ inch galvanized pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot and the Southwest corner of Lot 8 on the boundary of Wahiawa and Kalaheo, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papapaholahola" are 1368.6 feet South and 1444.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2378, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 269° 30' 2.9 feet along Lot 8 to a + on stone;
2. 266° 24' 520.3 feet along Lot 8 across a ditch to a + on stone;
3. 20° 22' 120.5 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
4. 357° 16' 253.6 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
5. 342° 12' 126.7 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
6. 31° 09' 118.8 feet along homestead road to a + on stone;
7. 109° 41' 629.5 feet along Lot 6 across a ditch to a + on stone;
8. 199° 41' 365.1 feet along the land of Wahiawa to the point of beginning.
