Beginning at a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe at the Northeast corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 78, the coordinates of said pipe referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Nale" being: 12390.4 feet North and 4436.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2579, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $359^{\circ} 28'$ 525.0 feet along Hawi Road to an iron rail;
2. $357^{\circ} 48'$ 66.2 feet along Hawi Road to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
3. $90^{\circ} 00'$ 1165.0 feet along Lot 76 to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
4. $182^{\circ} 25'$ 591.7 feet along Government land of Kahei to a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch pipe;
5. $270^{\circ} 00'$ 1132.5 feet along Lot 78 to the point of beginning.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 15 feet wide for the Hawi Mill and Plantation Company's flume, area $41/100$ Acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF $15-17/100$ ACRES.
