Beginning at the Northwest corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 5 on East side of trail, the coordinates from Government Survey Trig. Station "Paina" being S. 601.2 feet and E. 147.9 feet, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2262, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $293^{\circ} 22'$ 47.9 feet along Lot 5;
2. $255^{\circ} 25'$ 193.4 feet along Lot 5 to Lot 6;
3. $351^{\circ} 40'$ 42.5 feet along Lot 6;
4. $8^{\circ} 59'$ 122.9 feet along Lot 6 to Lot 8;
5. $13^{\circ} 44'$ 65.0 feet along Lot 8;
6. $105^{\circ} 43'$ 78.5 feet along Lot 8;
7. $18^{\circ} 40'$ 34.3 feet along Lot 8;
8. $96^{\circ} 18'$ 123.3 feet along Lots 8 and 9;
9. $182^{\circ} 11'$ 194.8 feet along Government Land to the initial point.
