Beginning at a mamane post at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 9 on the East side of the Waiohuli road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-o-Kali" being: 6919.0 feet South and 16653.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 264° 21' 32.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
2. 216° 40' 426.1 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
3. 188° 35' 211.6 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
4. 218° 43' 40.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
5. 204° 22' 32.0 feet along the Waiohuli road to a mamane post;
6. 309° 46' 2000.9 feet along Lot 7 to a mamane post on the boundary of the mauka pasture lands;
7. 39° 46' 700.0 feet along the mauka pasture lands to a mamane post;
8. 129° 46' 1889.2 feet along Lot 9 to the point of beginning.
