Beginning at the East corner of this piece, the West corner of a 20-Foot Roadway and Government Main Road, said point of beginning being by true azimuth and distance $73^{\circ} 56' 20.7$ feet from a mamane post at the South corner of Lot 85 of the Puukapu Homesteads, the coordinates of said mamane post is referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 3988.0 feet North and 5089.6 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $73^{\circ} 56'$ 879.3 feet along the North side of Government Main Road to the East edge of Lanimaumu Gulch;
2. Thence along the East edge of said gulch to an angle in same, the direct azimuth and distance being: $195^{\circ} 20'$ 757.0 feet;
3. $239^{\circ} 27'$ 307.9 feet along the remaining portion of Lot 84;
4. $329^{\circ} 27'$ 746.9 feet along 20-Foot Roadway to the point of beginning.

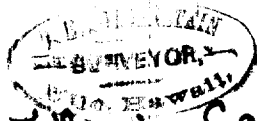

Beginning at a marked stone by intersection of stone walls from which point the Hawaii Govt Survey Δ Station "Mat" bears $N1^{\circ}36'W$ true distant 3613 ft the boundary runs by the true meridian
