Beginning at a pipe at the Northwest corner of this lot, the Northeast corner of Lot 9 and on the South side of homestead road, the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Pahiha" being: 1677.6 feet North and 4038.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2498, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 268° 05' 30" 596.7 feet along South side of homestead road to a pipe;
2. 347° 20' 486.5 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe;
3. 42° 23' 600.0 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe;
4. 7° 18' 113.0 feet along West side of homestead road to a pipe on the boundary of Papaikou;
5. 93° 30' 268.0 feet along the land of Papaikou to a post;
6. 179° 00' 993.7 feet along Lot 9 across two small streams to the point of beginning.
