2. $58^{\circ} 46'$ 137.7 feet along road to a + on stone;
3. $33^{\circ} 21'$ 194.1 feet along road to a + on stone;
4. $88^{\circ} 22'$ 10.3 feet along road to a + on stone;
5. $153^{\circ} 49'$ 208.5 feet along road to a + on stone;
6. $64^{\circ} 49'$ 209.9 feet along road to a + on stone;
7. $142^{\circ} 14'$ 33.7 feet along road to a + on stone;
8. $197^{\circ} 05'$ 256.1 feet along road to a + on stone;
9. $104^{\circ} 34'$ 156.4 feet along road to a + on stone;
10. $207^{\circ} 29'$ 1096.4 feet up slope along Lot 87 to a + on stone;
11. $254^{\circ} 47'$ 290.4 feet along Spring Reserve No. 1 to the point of beginning.
