Beginning at the Northwest corner of Grant 3635, Kealohaai, at + on stone and ahu on top of grassy rise at Kumu-Ohia on makai edge of ohia woods at a point whose coordinates referred to Akihi Trig. Station are 4793.3 feet S. and 7596.9 feet E., and from which ^{said} Akihi bears N 57° 45' W true, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running as follows by true bearings; all points being marked by + on stone and ahu, unless otherwise described:-

1. S 81° 0' W ²⁷⁶² ~~2800~~ feet along Lot 9 to an unmarked point;
2. N 7° 7' W ^{1957.5} ~~1940~~ feet along ~~Kahuku to a point at the base of a lefty~~ ^{40 foot road reservation to an} ~~unmarked point.~~ ^{Ohia tree at Wai-a-Keelea;}
3. N 68° 57' E ^{2933.8} ~~2975~~ feet along Forest Reserve to triangle mark on solid rock and ahu at Kaleleao;
4. N 89° 33' E 1096 feet along the same to a point between two small knolls
5. S 10° 19' E 2230 feet along Lot 4;
6. S 73° 10' W 1312 feet along Grant 3635, Kealohaai, to the initial point and containing an area of 211-1/10 Acres.
