Beginning at a mamane post at the West corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 88 and on the South side of the Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 4876.3 feet North and 3872.7 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 232° 02' 547.9 feet along the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
2. 346° 37' 2987.5 feet along Lot 92 to a mamane post;
3. 76° 10' 500.0 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
4. 166° 14' 956.0 feet along the Paiakuli Reserve to a mamane post;
5. 166° 51' 1807.1 feet along Lot 88 to the point of beginning.

Area 33-15/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a Right-of-Way to the Parker Ranch for a Pipe Line, said right-of-way being 6 feet wide and 810 feet long; also, excepting and reserving a Right-of-Way 20 feet wide for the ditch across this lot (area 49/100 Acre); LEAVING A NET AREA OF 32-66/100 ACRES.
