Beginning at a spike and pile of stones at the North corner of this lot and on the Southeast side of Kilohana Avenue, the coordinates of which referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Halai" being 3514.9 feet North and 10406.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2383, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 287° 24' 30" 184.56 feet along Lots 6 and 2 to spike and pile of stones;
2. 59° 48' 30" 101.55 feet along Waiakea to spike and pile of stones;
3. 107° 24' 30" 115.80 feet along Lot 9 to spike and pile of stones;
4. 197° 24' 30" 75.00 feet along Kilohana Avenue to the point of beginning.
