Puukapu Homesteads (Second Series)

Puukapu, Waimea, South Kohala, Hawaii.

Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 94 and on the South side of the Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 5442.9 feet North and 2994.5 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 346° 23' 3103.3 feet along Lot 94 to a mamane post;
2. 75° 10' 500.0 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3. 166° 37' 2987.5 feet along Lot 89 to a mamane post;
4. 232° 02' 134.0 feet along the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
5. 246° 39' 371.2 feet along the Government Main Road to the point of beginning.

Area 34-67/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a Right-of-Way to the Parker Ranch for a Pipe Line, said right-of-way being 6 feet wide and 810 feet long; also, excepting and reserving a Right-of-Way 20 feet wide for the ditch across this lot (area 49/100 Acre); LEAVING A NET AREA OF 34-18/100 ACRES.
