Beginning at a 4" x 4" red wood post at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 9A, on the East side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Akihi" being 7213.0 feet South and 5021.5 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2176, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 182° 13' 170.0 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence;
2. 189° 20' 373.5 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence to a + on set stone;
3. 167° 25' 255.5 feet along the East side of 40 foot road along fence to 4" x 4" red wood post;
4. 270° 39' 2309.0 feet along Lot 9C to a + on set stone and ahu;
5. 8° 45' 796.0 feet along Grant 3635 to Kealohaai to 4" x 4" red wood post;
6. 90° 39' 2199.5 feet along Lot 9A to the point of beginning.
