Beginning at a mamane post on the East side of the homestead road and the West corner of Lot 8, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu o Kali" being: 6919.0 feet South and 16653.7 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2494, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 309° 46' 1889.2 feet along Lot 8 to a mamane post on the boundary of the Mauka Pasture land;
2. 39° 46' 1400.0 feet along said land to a mamane post;
3. 129° 46' 1514.0 feet along Lot 11 to a mamane post on the East side of homestead road;
4. 219° 16" 40.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
5. 226° 03' 215.0 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
6. 189° 27' 282.2 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
7. 203° 43' 630.5 feet along East side of homestead road to a mamane post;
8. 204° 22' 307.0 feet along East side of homestead road to the point of beginning.

Area 54-01/100 Acres.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a right of way 40 feet wide across this lot for a public road, said right of way containing an area of 1-54/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 52-47/100 ACRES.
