Beginning at an iron rail at the East corner of this lot, the South corner of Lot 9 and on the North side of 40 foot road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being ~~20115.9~~^{20123.6} feet North and ~~9775.9~~^{9765.2} feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. ~~2382~~²⁵⁷⁴, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 40° 00' 695.0 feet along 40 foot road to an iron rail;
2. 146° 55' 772.0 feet along Lots 11 and 4 to an iron rail;
3. 236° 55' 663.0 feet along Lots 3 and 2 to an iron rail;
4. 326° 43' 570.0 feet along Lot 9 to the point of beginning.

Area 10-23/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a right-of-way 10 feet wide across this lot for the flume, said right-of-way containing an area of 14/100 acre, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 10-09/100 ACRES.
