Manowaiopae Homesteads,  
North Hilo, Hawaii.

Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 115, and on the West side of Homestead Road, the coordinates of said point of referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Manowaiopae 3" being 3500.6 feet South and 8557.3 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No.2555, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 117° 27' 1107.4 feet along Lot 115 crossing Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 184° 24' 140.0 feet along near East edge of Laupahoehoe Gulch;
3. 244° 43' 166.7 feet along near South edge of Laupahoehoe Gulch;
4. 263° 00' 355.6 feet along near South edge of Laupahoehoe Gulch to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 298° 05' 1044.5 feet along Lot 117 crossing Homestead Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 70° 04' 96.7 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
7. 51° 34' 155.4 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
8. 84° 06' 141.9 feet along North side of Homestead Road;
9. 37° 40' 162.6 feet along West side of Homestead Road to the point of beginning.

Excepting and reserving therefrom a strip of land 30 feet wide
