Beginning at a mamane post at the South corner of this lot and the East corner of Lot 117 and on the North side of the Government Main Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 7409.1 feet North and 4439.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $166^{\circ} 10'$ 3107.8 feet along Lot 117 to a mamane post;
2. $256^{\circ} 10'$ 600.6 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3. $346^{\circ} 10'$ 3083.3 feet along Lot 121 to a mamane post;
4. $73^{\circ} 50'$ 600.5 feet along the Government Main Road to the point of beginning.
