Beginning at the northeast corner of this parcel of land, on the north boundary of Grant 6019 to Frank Vierra (Lot 12, Hakalau-Iki House Lots), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KAUKU" being 21438.97 feet North and 10398.26 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map 2549 (HTS Plat 751), thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 28° 32' 108.31 feet;
2. 27° 56' 110.49 feet;
3. 71° 22' 14.54 feet along Grant 6017 to Manuel Medeiros Jordao (Lot 10, Hakalau-Iki House Lots);
4. 207° 56' 121.11 feet;
5. 208° 32' 97.59 feet;
6. 251° 22' 14.70 feet along Grant 6020 to Phebe Vierra Toledo (Lot 13, Hakalau-Iki House Lots), to the point of beginning and containing an Area of 2,188 Square Feet.
