Beginning at a mamane post at the North corner of this lot and the South corner of the Government Main Road and a 40 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 7522.2 feet North and 5008.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $346^{\circ} 10'$ 3207.7 feet along a 40 foot Homestead Road to a mamane post;
2. $76^{\circ} 10'$ 580.0 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3. $166^{\circ} 10'$ 3184.2 feet along Lot 118 to a mamane post;
4. $253^{\circ} 50'$ 580.5 feet along the Government Main Road to the point of beginning.

Area 42-55/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a Right-of-way 20 feet wide for the ditch across this lot, (area 37/100 acre); LEAVING A NET AREA OF 42-18/100 ACRES.
