Beginning at an iron pipe on the Easterly line of this lot and on the West side of Homestead Road (40 feet wide), the coordinates of said pipe referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being; 13571.7 feet North and 4329.4 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2382, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 356° 07' 91.9 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
2. 90° 49' 193.8 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
3. 73° 22' 216.0 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
4. 91° 20' 163.1 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
5. 62° 14' 149.4 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
6. 70° 42' 217.8 feet along Homestead Road (40 feet wide) to a pipe;
7. 134° 00' 883.0 feet along Lot 13 to a post on the South bank of Kaahakini Gulch;
8. Thence down the middle of Kaahakini Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance to a post on the South gulch bank of said Lot 11 being: 218° 00' 960.0 feet;
9. 319° 00' 1432.0 feet along Lot 11 to the point of beginning.
