Beginning at a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe at the South corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 13, and on the North side of Lepoloa Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Honohing^(Old)" being 2800.4 feet South and 1560.9 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No 2588 and running by true azimuths:-

1. 157° 50' 1148.3 feet along Lot 13 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
2. 240° 45' 346.1 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
3. 233° 50' 291.9 feet along Grant 1539 to Pea to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
4. 337° 45' 1260.6 feet along Lot 11 to a 1 inch galvanized iron pipe;
5. 67° 44' 30" 628.7 feet along North side of Lepoloa Road to the point of beginning.
