Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the North corner of this lot, the East corner of Lot 13, and on the South side of Uweki Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa" being 6405.7 feet South and 5557.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 320° 40' 510.0 feet along South side of Uweki Road;
2. 331° 02' 245.1 feet along South side of Uweki Road;
3. 344° 06' 137.9 feet along South side of Uweki Road;
4. 3° 17' 191.7 feet along South side of Uweki Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe on the boundary of the land of Maulua Nui.
5. 53° 24' 442.9 feet along the land of Maulua Nui to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 131° 15' 1026.0 feet along Lot 14 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
7. 231° 40' 840.0 feet along Lot 13 to the point of beginning.
