5. $230^{\circ} 40'$ 64 feet along L.C.A. 3424B to Kaleleiki;
6. $173^{\circ} 00'$ 187 feet along L.C.A. 3424B to Kaleleiki;
7. $331^{\circ} 35'$ 40 feet along L.C.A. 5834 to Keaweawea;
8. $66^{\circ} 10'$ 10 feet along Prison Lot;
9. $334^{\circ} 25'$ 213 feet along Prison Lot to the initial point.
