Beginning at a \triangle on set stone at the South corner of this lot and the West corner of Lot 17A, on the East side of 20 foot road, the coordinates of said point referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Puu-a-Ao" being 4551.2 feet North and 952.3 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2477, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $176^{\circ} 20'$ 352.0 feet along the East side of 20 foot road to + on set stone;
2. $242^{\circ} 50'$ 50.0 feet along Lot 30A to + on set stone;
3. $327^{\circ} 36'$ 324.2 feet along Government land to \triangle on set stone;
4. $62^{\circ} 50'$ 220.0 feet along Lot 17A to the point of beginning.
