Beginning at the East corner of this lot at a post marked XII-XIV at the West edge of 50 foot road reserve, the coordinates of which point are 3952.8 feet South and 8780.4 feet West of "Papaalooa" Trig. Station, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 28° 30' 670.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve to a post;
2. 118° 30' 932.7 feet along Lot 10 to a post on the East bank of Kilau Gulch;
3. Along the East bank of Kilau Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 213° 42' 673.0 feet to a post marked XIII-XIV;
4. 298° 30' 871.5 feet along Lot 14 to the point of beginning.

Total Area 15-15/100 Acres.

Excepting and Reserving therefrom a strip of land 50 feet wide across this lot for a public road, said road strip containing an area of 1-83/100 acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 13-32/100 ACRES.
