Beginning at a mamane post at the East corner of this lot and the North corner of Lot 136 and on the Southwest side of a 40 foot Homestead Road, the co-ordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "East Base" being 7280.8 feet North and 12066.8 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2552, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 28° 04' 2987.8 feet along Lot 136 to a mamane post;
2. 118° 44' 600.0 feet along Government Land to a mamane post;
3. 208° 04' 2741.0 feet along Lot 134 to a mamane post;
4. 265° 08' 445.6 feet along the Honokaa Branch of the Government Main Road to a mamane post;
5. 298° 44' 226.1 feet along the 40 foot Homestead Road to the point of beginning.
