Lot 13, Kula. Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Northwest corner of Lot 14, on the East side of road, the approximate coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Keanae Uka" being 1174 feet North and 2234 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2238, and running by true azimuths:-

1.  $197^{\circ} 00'$  240.0 feet along the East side of road;
2.  $281^{\circ} 55'$  147.0 feet along Lot 12 to top of pali at seacoast;
3. Thence following along top of pali at seacoast, the direct azimuth and distance being:  $360^{\circ} 00'$  239.6 feet;
4.  $100^{\circ} 42'$  218.0 feet along Lot 14 to the point of beginning.

1.  $204^{\circ} 20'$  85.0 feet along government land;
2.  $193^{\circ} 20'$  106.0 feet along same;
