Beginning at a post marked XIV-XVII at the East corner of this lot and on the West side of road reserve, the coordinates of which point are 3302.6 feet South and 8427.3 feet West of Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloa", as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2256, and running by true azimuths:

1. 28° 30' 740.0 feet along 50 foot road reserve;
2. 118° 30' 871.5 feet along Lot 13 to a post on bank of Kilau Gulch
3. Along the East bank of Kilau Gulch, the direct azimuth and distance being: 203° 59' 742.0 feet to a post marked XIV-XVII ;
4. 298° 30' 930.1 feet along Lot 17 to the point of beginning.
