Beginning at a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe at the West corner of this lot, on the North boundary of Lot 15 and the East side of Weloka Road, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Papaaloea" being 7186.7 feet South and 4409.6 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2582, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 192° 46' 108.8 feet along East side of Weloka Road;
2. 139° 32' 141.9 feet along East side of Weloka Road;
3. 216° 21' 73.4 feet along East side of Weloka Road;
4. 193° 28' 328.3 feet along East side of Weloka Road;
5. 153° 00' 103.8 feet along East side of Weloka Road to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
6. 311° 15' 1670.4 feet along Lots 13 and 12 to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe on the boundary of the land of Maulua Nui;
7. 53° 24' 530.0 feet along the land of Maulua Nui to a 2½ inch galvanized iron pipe;
8. 131° 15' 1110.9 feet along Lot 15 to the point of beginning.
