Beginning at the Southwest corner of this lot and the Southeast corner of Lot 13, Honokaa Section, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 1878, and running by true azimuths:-

1. $195^{\circ} 16'$ 3105.0 feet along Lot 13, Honokaa Section;
2. Thence along the South side of 50 foot road, the direct azimuth and distance being: $304^{\circ} 45'$ 208.0 feet;
3. $15^{\circ} 16'$ 3000.0 feet along Lot 14 Honokaa Section, (Grant 4997 to L.M. Broderick);
4. $94^{\circ} 55'$ 200.0 feet along Government land to the point of beginning.
