Beginning at a post marking the Northeast angle of this Lot on South edge of roadway, the coordinates of said point referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 4753.7 feet North and 2185.2 feet East, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2296, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 67° 02' 635.5 feet along South edge of 56 foot roadway;
2. 108° 10' 460.0 feet along same;
3. 128° 39' 264.2 feet along same;
4. 69° 02' 174.0 feet along same to Northwest angle;
5. 357° 16' 1211.2 feet along Lot 16 to post marking the Southwest angle at North edge of 100 foot width Forest Reserve along top edge of pali of Kaholongo gulch;
6. 263° 50' 688.0 feet along North edge of said reserve to post;
7. 326° 50' 100.0 feet;
8. 240° 50' 569.6 feet along top edge of pali of said gulch;
9. 232° 07' 40" 594.4 feet along same;
10. 146° 50' 130.0 feet along Lot 14;
11. 147° 19' 558.5 feet along Lot 14 to point of beginning;
