Lot 16.

Beginning at a post marking the Northeast angle of this lot, at South edge of roadway, the coordinates of said point referred to the Government Survey Trig. Station "Kauku" being 4751.9 feet North and 794.2 feet East as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2296, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 72° 47' 42" 637.6 feet along South edge of 56 foot roadway;
2. 66° 17' 20" 439.4 feet along South edge of 100 foot width Forest Reserve along top of pali of Paheehee gulch;
3. 32° 14' 805.7 feet along same;
4. 326° 42' 830.0 feet along Lot 17 to post marking the Southwest angle at North edge of 100 foot width Forest Reserve;
5. 235° 30' 627.8 feet along North edge of said reserve;
6. 242° 05' 392.0 feet along same;
7. 301° 05' 90.0 feet along same;
8. 249° 40' 110.0 feet along same to Southwest angle of this lot;
9. 177° 16' 1211.2 feet along Lot 15 to point of beginning.

*Excepting* Reserving a roadway 30 feet wide to Lot 17.
